### ***Use(s)***

temporarily

- shrinks hemorrhoidal tissues
- relieves itching, burning and discomfort associated with hemorrhoids

### ***Warnings***

For rectal use only

#### **Do not use**

#### **Ask a doctor before use if you have**

- heart disease
- high blood pressure
- diabetes
- thyroid disease
- trouble urinating due to an enlarged prostate gland

#### **Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if you are**

now taking a prescription drug for high blood pressure or depression

#### **When using this product**

do not use more than the recommended daily dosage

#### **Stop use and ask a doctor if**

- bleeding occurs
- condition gets worse or does not improve within 7 days

#### **If pregnant or breast-feeding**

#### **Keep out of reach of children**

If swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

### ***Directions***

- children under 12 years of age: ask a doctor
- Adults:
- if possible, clean the affected area by patting or blotting with an appropriate cleansing pad
- gently dry by patting or blotting with toilet tissue or a soft cloth before insertion of this product
- detach one suppository from strip
- remove wrapper before inserting into the rectum
- hold suppository with rounded end up and carefully peel film slowly and evenly down both sides to expose suppository
- insert one suppository into rectum up to 4 times daily especially at night and morning or after each bowel movement

### ***Other information***

store at room temperature but not over 89°F (32°C)

methylparaben, propylparaben, starch
