- 1. Empty the contents of one Saline Sinus Wash packet into the Classic Neti Pot. First-time users should start with 1/2 packet of the dry ingredients. As you become more accustomed to the system, work up to using 1 full packet. Additional packets may be purchased from your nearest pharmacy.
- 2. Fill the pot halfway or to the middle of the indentation with proper water. This makes 1/2 cup (4 oz) solution.
