## **WARNINGS**

**Reye's syndrome**: Children and teenagers who have or are recovering from chicken pox or flu-like symptoms should not use this product. # Stop use and ask a doctor if

- you experience any of the following signs of stomach bleeding: feel faint, vomit blood, have bloody or black stools, have stomach pain that does not get better
- new symptoms occur
- redness or swelling is present
- ringing in the ears or loss of hearing occurs
