# Warnings

## Do not use

- if you have had an allergic reaction to salicylates (including aspirin) or any other pain reliever / fever reducer.
- if you are now taking a prescription monoamine oxidase inhibitor (MAOI) (certain drugs for depression, psychiatric, or emotional conditions, or Parkinson's disease), or 2 weeks after stopping the MAOI durg. If you do not know if your prescription drug contains an MAOI, ask a doctor or pharmacist before taking this product.
- if you have ever had an allergic reaction to this product or any of its ingredients
- in children under 12 years of age

# Ask a doctor before use if

- stomach bleeding warning applies to you
- you have a history of stomach problems, such as heartburn or if you have ulcers or bleeding problems
- you have high blood pressure, heart disease, liver cirrhosis, kidney disease, diabetes, or thyroid disease
- you have a cough with excessive phlegm (mucus)
- you have difficulty in urination due to enlargement of the prostate gland
- you have a persistent or chronic cough such as occurs with smoking, asthma, chronic bronchitis, or emphysema
- you have a chronic pulmonary disease or shortness of breath
- you have a sodium restricted diet

# Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if you are

- taking a prescription drug for anticoagulation (thinning the blood) diabetes, gout, or arthritis.
- under a doctor's care for any serious condition
- taking a diuretic

# When using this product do not use more than directed

## Stop use and ask a doctor if

- an allergic reaction occurs. Seek medical help right away.
- pain, cough, or nasal congestion gets worse or lasts more than 7 days
- fever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days
- redness or swelling is present
- new symptoms occur
- ringing in the ears or a loss of hearling occurs
- cough comes back or occurs with rash or headache that lasts. These could be signs of a serious

condition.

- nervousness, dizziness, or sleeplessness occurs
- you experience any of the following signs of stomach bleeding
- feel faint
- vomit blood
- have bloody or black stools
- have stomach pain that does not get better

**If pregnant or breast-feeding,** ask a health professional before use. It is especially important not to use salicylates (NSAIDs) during the last 3 months of pregnancy unless definitely directed to do so by a doctor because it may cause problems in the unborn child or complications during delivery.

**Keep out of reach of children.** In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

- Use enclosed dose cup
