Pre-Milking: Fill teat cup with Medic Booster® Peroxide Dip. Do not dilute. Before each cow is milked, dip the teats as far as possible into the teat cup containing Medic Booster® Peroxide Dip. Wipe teats dry after dipping/spraying using single-service towels to avoid contamination of milk.

Udders and teats which are heavily soiled should be washed before using a premilking teat dip/spray. Teats should then be dried with a single-service towels and dipped/sprayed in Medic Booster®

Peroxide Dip, wiping teats before milking.

Post-Milking: Immediately after milking, use Medic Booster® Peroxide Dip at full strength. Submerge entire teat in Medic Booster® Peroxide Dip. Allow to air dry. Do not wipe.

Always use full strength Medic Booster® Peroxide Dip. If product becomes visibly dirty, discard contents and replenish with undiluted Medic Booster® Peroxide Dip. Do not reuse or return to original container.

Do not allow cows out in freezing weather until dip is completely dry. Use proper procedures for udder washing or pre-milking teat dipping/spraying just prior to next milking to avoid contamination of milk.
