- feel faint
- vomit blood
- have bloody or black stools
- have stomach pain that does not get better

you have symptoms of heart problems or stroke:

- chest pain
- trouble breathing
- weakness in one part or side of body
- slurred speech
- leg swelling
- pain gets worse or lasts more than 10 days
- fever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days
- redness or swelling is present in the painful area
- any new symptoms appear

If pregnant or breast-feeding

ask a health professional before use. It is especially important not to use ibuprofen at 20 weeks or later in pregnancy

unless definitely directed to do so by a doctor because it may cause problems in the unborn child or

complications during delivery.

Keep out of reach of children.

In case of overdose, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center (1-800-222-1222) right away.

Directions

- do not take more than directed
- the smallest effective dose should be used

Adults and children 12 years and older:

- take 1 softgel every 4 to 6 hours while symptoms persist
- if pain or fever does not respond to 1 softgel, 2 softgels may be used


