- use only as directed. Frequent or prolonged use may cause nasal congestion to recur or worsen.

Do not use if you have ever had an allergic reaction to this product or any of its ingredients.

Do not use more than directed.

Do not use for more than 3 days.

**Ask a doctor before use if you have:**

- heart disease
- high blood pressure
- thyroid disease
- diabetes
- trouble urinating due to an enlarged prostate gland

Stop use and ask a doctor if symptoms persist.

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If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use.

Keep out of reach of children. If swallowed, get medical help or contact a Poison Control Center right away.

- to spray, squeeze bottle quickly and firmly
- adults and children 6 to under 12 years of age (with adult supervision): 2 or 3 sprays in each nostril not more often than every 4 hours
- Children under 6 years of age: ask a doctor

- Store at room temperature, 59° - 86° F (15° -30° C)
- Retain carton for future reference on full labeling
