- leg swelling

- any new symptoms appear
- fever gets worse or lasts more than 3 days
- you have difficulty swallowing or the caplet feels stuck in your throat
- you get nervous, dizzy, or sleepless
- nasal congestion lasts more than 7 days

#### If pregnant or breast-feeding,


