Provide 100 g/ton chlortetracycline, 100 g/ton sulfathiazole, and 50 g/ton of penicillin by thoroughly mixing 2.5 lb (1.14 kg) of AureoZol 500 Granular into each ton (907.2 kg) of complete swine feed for the following indications.

Administer to swine in a complete medicated feed for reduction of the incidence of cervical abscesses; treatment of bacterial enteritis (salmonellosis or necrotic enteritis caused by *Salmonella choleraesuis* and vibronic dysentery); maintenance of weight gains in the presence of atrophic rhinitis; increased rate of weight gain and improved feed efficiency from 10 pounds of body weight to 6 weeks postweaning. For swine raised in confinement (dry-lot) or on limited pasture.

Grower and Finisher Feeds

Administer to swine in a complete medicated feed for reduction of the incidence of cervical abscesses; treatment of bacterial enteritis (salmonellosis or necrotic enteritis caused by *Salmonella choleraesuis* and vibronic dysentery); maintenance of weight gains in the presence of atrophic rhinitis; increased rate of weight gain from 6 to 16 weeks post-weaning. For swine raised in confinement (dry-lot) or on limited pasture.
