### Directions

- **for itching of skin irritation, inflammation, and rashes :**
- adults and children 2 years of age and older: apply to affected area not more than 3 to 4 times daily

- **for external anal and genital itching, adults :**
- when practical, cleanse the affected area with mild soap and warm water and rinse thoroughly
- gently dry by patting or blotting with toilet tissue or a soft cloth before applying
- apply to affected area not more than 3 to 4 times daily
- children under 12 years of age: ask a doctor
