Uses

Warnings

Ask a doctor before use if you have

- diabetes
- trouble urinating due to an enlarged prostate gland.

When using this product

- **do not exceed recommended dosage**
- do not use more than 3 days.
- Use only as directed.
- frequent or prolonged use may cause nasal congestion to recur or worsen
- temporary discomfort such as burning, stinging, sneezing, or an increase in nasal discharge may occur
- the use of this container by more than one person may spread infection
- Infection may spread if this container is used by more than one person

Directions

- **adults and children 12 years of age and older:** 2 or 3 sprays in each nostril not more than every 4 hours
- **children under 12 years of age:** ask a doctor
- Use instructions: with head in a normal, upright position, put atomizer tip into nostril. Squeeze bottle with firm, quick pressure while inhaling. Wipe nozzle clean after each use.
