## Drug Facts

#### Active ingredient (in each capsule)

Solubilized ibuprofen equal to 200 mg ibuprofen USP (NSAID)\* (present as the free acid and potassium salt) \*nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug

#### Purpose

Pain reliever/Fever reducer

## Directions

- do not take more than directed




