ASK A DOCTOR BEFORE USE

Ask a doctor before use if

- stomach bleeding warning applies to you
- you have problems or serious side effects from taking pain relievers or frever reducers
- you have a history of stomach problems, such as heartburn
- you have high blood pressure, heart disease, liver cirrhosis, kidney disease, asthma, had a stroke, you are taking a diuretic

Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if

- Taking aspirin for a heart attack or stroke, because ibuprofen may decrease this benefit of asprin
- taking any other drug

WHEN USING THIS PRODUCT

When using this product take with food or milk if stomach upset occurs

STOP USE AND ASK A DOCTOR

Stop use and ask a doctor if you experience any of the following signs of stomach bleeding:

- feel faint
- vomit
- blood
- have bloody or black stools
- stomach pain that does not get better
- symptoms of heart problems or stroke
- chest pain
- trouble breathing
- weakness in one part or side of body
- slurred speech
- leg swelling
- pain gets worse or last more than 10 days
- fever gets worse or last more than 3 days
- redness or swelling is present in the painful area
- any new symptoms appear

IF PREGNANT OR BREAST FEEDING

If pregnant or breast-feeding, ask a health professional before use. It is especially important not to use ibuprofen during the last 3 months of pregnancy unless definitely directed to do so by a doctor because it may cause problems in the unborn child or complications during delivery.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

Keep out of reach of children.

Overdose warning: In case of overdose, seek medical help or contact a Poison Control Center (1-800-222-1222) right away.

Quick medical attention is critical for adults as well as for children even if you do not notice any signs or symptoms.
